A position is available for a part-time Industrial Tutor to work on the MPhil in Industrial Systems, Manufacture and Management (ISMM) course based at the Institute for Manufacturing.

The ISMM course is designed to prepare graduates from numerate disciplines for fast track careers in industry through an intensive programme of taught modules and industrial projects. Industrial visits are an integral part of the programme and students spend more than half their time in companies in the UK or mainland Europe to gain experience of good industrial practice.

The ISMM course is supported by a number of Industrial Tutors who facilitate a broad range of industrial activities to support the taught programme. They include visits to companies and factories across the UK. The Tutors identify, organise and assess meaningful problem solving and business improvement projects which underpin the taught elements of the programme. The ISMM course is seeking to appoint a new Industrial Tutor to join the team.

The successful candidate will have extensive industrial experience in manufacturing or allied industries in technical, operational and strategic roles typically at senior management levels. Experience of training, coaching and mentoring will be particularly welcome as will strong networking capabilities across industries.

Industrial Tutors are employed on a part-time, variable-hour contract depending on the needs of the course. Although based in Cambridge the course works throughout the UK and applicants from outside the county are welcome to apply.
